What are Neighborhood Greenways?

Neighborhood greenways are low-speed, low-volume shared roadways that create a high-comfort walking and bicycling environment. In addition to shared lane markings and wayfinding signs, traffic calming or diversion treatments are often used to promote speed and volume reduction.

Past Neighborhood Greenway projects have shown an increase in the number of people walking, rolling, and bicycling in the area.

Each Neighborhood Greenway is a part of a network, to connect many residents with many destinations throughout the community.

Why the intersection?

The Neighborhood Greenway north of this intersection (from Hillside Drive to 3rd Street) has been designed. That design and process did not include the intersection at Hillside Drive.

This intersection is an important link in the Neighborhood Greenway between neighborhoods and destinations north and south of Hillside. This intersection exposes users to a high-volume of cross traffic and acts as a barrier between neighborhoods. This intersection design is following the Neighborhood Greenways process.
