Any amount may be contributed at any time to the Bloomington Tree Fund. All Bloomington Tree Fund gifts are tax deductible as prescribed by law.




Indiana's First Tree City

Bloomington was recognized by the National Arbor Day Foundation in 1984 as Indiana's first Tree City USA. Bloomington has each year since 1984 successfully met all the criteria necessary to keep its Tree City USA designation such as a tree board or department. In 2021, Bloomington was recognized as a Tree City of the World. They have continued to be recognized every year since. Bloomington has also qualified for the Tree City Growth Award since 2018 and continues to strive for urban forestry excellence.
